WEBEX tip of the week: Notifications

As we continue to learn all about our newest communication tool, Webex, we continue to find helpful tips we will share with you all. This week's tip is how to set up and control your "Notifications" in Webex. If you belong to a particular team or space, you may get many notifications popping up on your screen, depending on how frequently this team/space is used. If you find that these notifications don't pertain to you, you have the option to Mute the

notifications.

If you right click on any particular team/space you will see the following options.

Global

Notifications for all spaces: All messages You can change your notification preferences for all your spaces in <u>Settings</u>.

Custom

You can choose custom notifications or turn off all notifications for this space.

This space won't show in your spaces list. It will show in search results, in Teams, or when you filter by @Mentions or Flags. Click on notification and you will open a menu of options. You can turn off all notifications, or you can choose to shut off notifications just for this particular space. You are in control!
